Hello fellow Rotarians,

There are still four weeks in this Rotary year to help "Make Dreams Real."

The most effective way for all of us to help others is through our Rotary Foundation.

PDG Gene Beil issued us a challenge a couple of months ago. Total Annual Giving to The Rotary Foundation from our District for the past two years was \$678,000. He asked us to try to break the ONE MILLION DOLLAR barrier for the three year period.

That means we need only \$322,000 in giving this year. That sum is less than either of the two previous years but we only have thirty days to achieve our goal. As of this very minute our giving this year stands at a very respectable.....

**\$231,306.35**

That leaves us with a goal for June of \$90,693.65. Last June we contributed \$59,103.83 so we know that we can do it if we try. If the remaining Clubs which have not reached their stated goal were to make their individual goals we would exceed the ONE MILLION DOLLAR mark by more than \$5,000.00.

If your Club is planning on turning in a Matching Grant soon please note that the District Match will be \$3 to \$1 this new Rotary year. Get your request in by late this month if you want your best chance of securing the funds you are requesting. Remember also that we will start accepting District Simplified Grant request on July 1st. DON'T QUIT JUST YET..... but still "HAVE FUN"
