

In addition we have Rotary's USD200 Million Challenge, which affects the annual giving, thus also the two other fundraising programs.

It is important that when we give money, we must donate to all of the above initiatives. By remembering this, we can continue *Building Communities* — *Bridging Continents* through Service Above Self.
