Over 300,000 homes will need to be re-build. Schools, businesses and government offices all have been destroyed. In some cases, the properties where homes once stood, no longer exists.

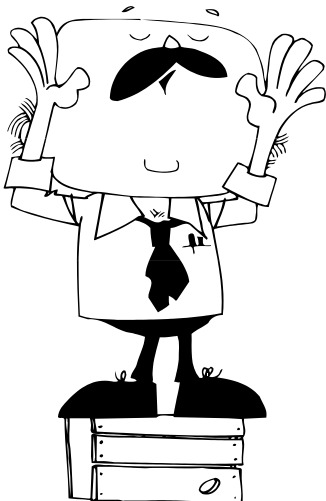
