This promises to be a fun and informative meeting.

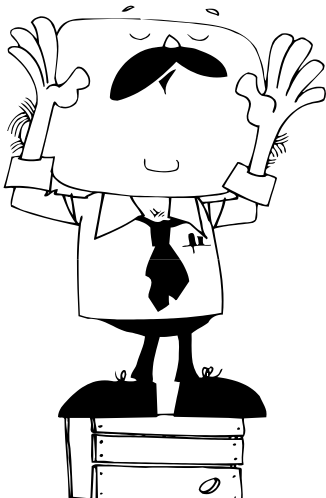
The Marine Science Station is often confused with the Academy of Environmental Science which is on the right side after the bridge.
